10:00 a.m. Welcome

The Org/Finance Committee met and Bonnie joined us by zoom to do a comprehensive review of the April 2019 financials. • Fire Inspection for Boys and Girls update (Fire Chief) RE: NOC

The Committee discussed the NOC that was received for the Boys and Girls Club for not having a fire inspection. The Chief fire inspector would not provide a fire inspection but did provide a note stating why they would not conduct this as the Boys and Girls Club does not have a County Certificate of Occupancy for a school. This letter was provided to Sione Thompson as soon as it was received with the information that the school is no longer at the temporary relocation facility of the Boys and Girls Club due to the loss of our campus to lava.

The June submission of a 2019/2020 budget will be based upon this years current number of students. While we are losing students due to having to shut down the face to face opportunity for high school students due to not having a facility, we anticipate more online students.

The Committee will be scheduling time to work on the 5 year budget as required to submit as part of the renewal contract.

- County use Occupancy for Nani Mau update
- An update was provided on the County Use Occupancy for the Nani Mau site. We are requesting a 'Temporary Certificate of Occupancy' while we proceed with bringing the building to 'school level' compliance. The draft architecture is almost complete. There is some ADA cement work to be done, some work with toilets, some classroom 'as built' construction needs to occur also. A meeting has been set with SUN Construction to review the plans and understand what we are looking at. The Rotary Funds will be used first and then we will see if we need to have a procurement process for further work to be paid by the school.
